#### Welcome to the Ira Dorsey Scholarship Endowment Fund scholarship application!

If you have no information to enter in a section simply enter "None" or "N/A." Incomplete applications will not be considered.

This application will take approximately 30-45 minutes to complete. After completing section 2, we recommend copying your unique URL into an email and sending it to yourself and/or a parent or guardian for safekeeping. Should you have to resume at a later time for any reason, you may click on that unique URL to continue your scholarship application.
